Alarm instructions

General Safety Rules

Before every alarm you hear a gong signal and an announcement!



Gong signal Verbal announcement

Entire terrain:

 Proceed according to verbal announcement.

Evacuation

Intermittent low tone

Fire

Alternating high and low tone

Announced area:

- Interrupt activities in a controlled way, switch off equipment, shut windows and doors and warn colleagues.
- Evacuate area. Take work permit and belongings with you.
- Proceed to assembly point.
- All work permits are cancelled!

MMM

Escape

Wailing tone

Area where alarm sounds:

- Immediately interrupt activities!
- All work permits are cancelled!
- Controlled area: to nuclear assembly point building 15. Do not change clothes. Use escape mask.
- All others: Immediately proceed to assembly point.

End of alarm

Continuous low tone

Entire terrain:

 Resubmit work permits to resume activities in affected area.

Every Monday the alarm signals are tested at 11.30 am.

Obligatory

- Wear your badge visibly
- Safety helmets, safety goggles, safety shoes and industrial clothing with long sleeves and trousers are to be used on the site within the blue zones
- Observe safety rules
- Cooperate with access control and Security requests
- Keep escape routes (yellow arrows) and safety equipment clear
- Keep fire door closed
- Request a work permit
- Use the required safety equipment
- Use reliable/good quality tools, with (electrical) inspection certificate
- Neat, clean and hygiene. Keep workplace tidy
- Prevent soil/ground, air and water pollution
- Separate waste streams
- Respect working areas which have been cordoned off

Prohibited

- Possession and use of alcohol and drugs
- Eating and drinking at work location
- Using mobile devices in extra secured area (behind blue doors) without written permission
- Mobile (smart) phones and smart watches behind the blue doors
- Operate electrical and process components
- Climbing on pipes
- Transporting tools by ladder or working from a ladder
- Using unchecked ladders and scaffolds or modify in one's own hand
- Making videos/photos without written permission
- Block escape routes (yellow arrows)
- Leave parts, tools or resources behind after the work is done
