

Monitoring and Security

EPZ takes the necessary measures to monitor and protect its company and installations, the Borssele Nuclear Power Plant in particular, the available fissionable materials and information so they do not fall into hands of unauthorised parties, that no violence is committed or damage is caused (sabotage) and that no such threats can be made.

EPZ ensures and will continuously improve:

- A security package that offers resistance to the reference threats established by the government;
- An integrated security system with different layers and methods of security (personnel, organisational, structural and electronic) that at least complies with laws and regulations;
- A system that ensures the confidentiality, availability and integrity of information and automated (process) systems;
- A system for registration and control of the fissionable materials present;
- An alarm plan that is regularly practised by EPZ and the authorities involved.

EPZ also promotes:

- A culture in which employees understand the security measures taken and actively participate in security;
- The coordination between those responsible for nuclear safety and radiation protection and those responsible for monitoring and security, so that joint care is taken to protect people and the environment.

Management and employees of EPZ are responsible for the implementation of the security policy and will ensure that (sub)contractors also comply with this policy.

Everyone is expected to support each other in the implementation, to address each other in the event of deviations and to prevent or resolve circumstances that hinder or disrupt the implementation of this policy.
